



Student Ambassadors Job Description, Targets and Rewards

Student ambassadors will be asked to commit to a minimum of 6 months in this position, ideally a year or more.

The main aspects of the post will involve:

- Recruiting other volunteers within your university to organise and support UK fundraising events.
- Planning and facilitating the organisation of fundraising events.
- Promoting V2Vs overseas volunteer programme
- Acting as the face of V2V for anyone enquiring within the university about volunteering both in the UK and overseas.

Targets:

Student ambassadors will be set the target of bringing in £500/semester in fundraising events. This is equivalent to organising one African music night or two days of cake sales. As well as recruiting 3 students to volunteer in Tanzania each year. Employers often look for individuals who are able to meet and exceed targets and will be of huge benefit to distinguishing yourself in the job market.

In return student ambassadors reaching targets will receive:

- A 10 day stay at the volunteer accommodation in Tanzania inclusive of food and transfers from the airport.
- A certificate to say that you have completed the placement
- A glowing reference to impress employers
- And the knowledge that you are making a huge difference to a small charity!
